CONSTITUTION OF A FUND RESERVED FOR EXPENSES RELATED TO THE PURCHASE OF IMMOVABLES SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT OF PRE-EMPTION – CHARGE TO THE ACCUMULATED SURPLUS

WHEREAS By-law 265, effective as of March 13, 2024, establishes designated territory where the right of pre-emption may be applied and defines the municipal objectives for which immovables may be acquired.
