Also, please hold any questions related to today's agenda items (resolutions) for the second question period. To help everyone, please follow these guidelines:

- Identify yourself and wait to be invited to speak.
- Address the chair of the meeting and specify to whom the question is intended.
- Ask only one question and one sub-question per turn.
- Use respectful language, without abusive, defamatory, or personal language.
- Formulate a brief, clear question on a public matter of interest under the jurisdiction of the Municipality.

Each person is allotted a maximum of 5 minutes to ask one question and one follow-up question. Each question period is limited to 30 minutes. The Chair may interrupt an intervention that exceeds the allotted time, includes additional questions, or falls outside municipal scope, to ensure the smooth progression of the meeting.
