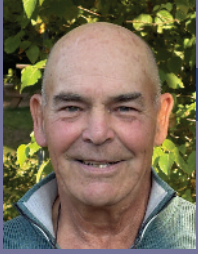

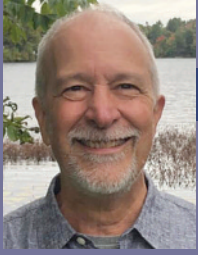

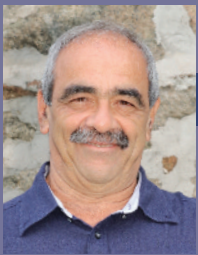

A WORD FROM THE MAYOR

Dear residents,

Summer is finally here... and let's be honest — after the seasons we've had, we've earned it! It's the perfect time to get outside, get moving, and enjoy everything our municipality has to offer.

At Lake Beattie Nature Park, we're introducing an activity this year that's as refreshing as it is invigorating : open water swimming. Yes, really — not just dipping your toes in! A designated swimming course is now available and open to everyone. One simple rule: a safety buoy is mandatory. Don't worry — we've got you covered. Free buoy loans will be available to all Gore residents, so no excuses! And for those who prefer not to go at it alone (we all know it's more fun that way), group swimming sessions will take place every Friday at 12:30 p.m. throughout the summer. You'll find all the details in this edition of the Gore Express.

Now, let's talk about something a little less fun than jumping in the water, but just as important: residual waste management. I'll be straightforward — sending waste to landfill is expensive. Very expensive. And that money? It's yours and mine.

Here's the good news: every time we recycle or compost properly, those materials cost us... nothing. Zero. We even receive royalties for everything that doesn't end up at the landfill! The less we send to landfill, the better we manage our municipal expenses. It's as simple as that. So yes, sorting your waste properly isn't just "good for the environment" — it's also good for our collective wallet.

In that same spirit, I want to emphasize the importance of using our ecocentre. Even with the monthly bulky item collection, some things simply don't belong at the curb — especially metal. Why? Because metal has value. When it's properly brought to the ecocentre, the municipality receives revenue from it. In other words, we go from "paying to throw away" to "getting paid to recover." Not a hard choice.

And since summer often means a good clean-up, now is the perfect time to go through your yard, garage, or shed. Before putting everything out by the road, think about the ecocentre... and Les Trésors du Dôme. What you no longer need could easily find a second life with someone else.

In short, enjoy the summer, enjoy our facilities... and take the opportunity to make choices that benefit the whole community.

UPDATE OF THE FAMILY AND SENIORS POLICY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GORE

The committee mandated by the municipal council to develop the update of the Family and Seniors Policy of the Township of Gore has met six times since September 2025.

The committee has now established various profiles to help it continue its work, namely a profile of Gore's community, families, and seniors. It has also followed through with the creation of an inventory of existing services and programs as well as a clear definition of what constitutes a family and a senior. It has identified the values to be promoted and carried out consultations with residents of the Township of Gore to further its findings. The committee also consulted community organizations to gather their feedback and build partnerships.

Using the information, suggestions, and comments collected, the committee is now determining the objectives and actions that will be included in the new Family and Seniors Policy action plan. The adoption of the policy is scheduled for early 2027—stay tuned!

This project is supported by the Government of Québec as part of the MADA initiative.

Ecolloan Program

What is it?

The Ecolloan program helps homeowners finance the replacement or upgrade of non-compliant septic systems through a municipal **loan** that is repaid via property taxes.

Who can apply?

- Owner of a property located in Gore
- Non compliant, old or contaminating septic system
- Commercial or industrial buildings
- Unpaid municipal taxes



Eligible projects

- Soil test done by a certified technologist
- Plans and reports
- Purchase and installation of the new system
- Excavation, plumbing and electrical work

Financial help

- 25 % to 90% : of admissible costs depending on:
 - Household income
 - Property value (without land)
- Minimum project cost of 5000 \$

How to proceed?

- 1 • Submit a complete application to the Municipality
- 2 • Eligibility review
- 3 • Signing of the funding agreement
- 4 • Completion of the work within 6 months
- 5 • Submission of final compliance report.



No work may be undertaken until a municipal permit has been obtained.

Swimming pools and spas: Properly managing water

Summer is finally here, but it's important to remember that water from residential pools and hot tubs (pool backwash, hot tub water changes) must be disposed of responsibly to protect the environment.

Good practices

- ✓ Direct this water onto the ground on your property, ideally onto a grassy area to encourage it to seep naturally into the soil.

A meaningful effort

- 🕒 It is recommended that you stop using chemicals at least one week before draining the tank to allow them to evaporate and reduce their toxicity.

To avoid

- ⊘ Never divert water onto a neighbor's property or into the street. Never discharge this water into a lake, stream, wetland, or riparian zone.

Why ?

- i Pool and spa water contains chlorine, bromine and salts; substances that are harmful for aquatic plants and animals.

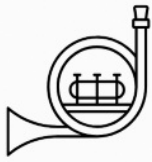

**CONSERVATION LAKEFIELD PROTECTS AN
ADDITIONAL 19,4 HECTARES IN GORE**

Conservation Lakefield is proud to announce the successful acquisition of Le Sommet, a spectacular forested ridge overlooking Lake Kenny and Lake Sir John in Gore, Québec. In 2024, Le Sommet faced an imminent threat of development. Today, it will remain a shared natural heritage site, protected for future generations.

This conservation project was made possible thanks to strong community support and generous donations from residents of Lake Sir John and Domaine Lakefield. The project was supported by the Fondation de la faune du Québec, in partnership with the Nature Conservancy of Canada, as part of the Accélérer la conservation dans le sud du Québec (ACSQ) initiative, for which the Government of Québec provided financial assistance, as well as by Nature Action Québec through funding from Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC).

ACTIVITIES

ANNUAL MEETING OF THE ALLIANCE OF GORE LAKE ASSOCIATIONS

On April 26th, the Alliance of Gore lake associations held its annual meeting.

The Alliance organizing committee was pleased to welcome 43 participants representing 23 lakes within the Township of Gore (see map). Each year, the room gets more crowded!

Representatives from lakes outside the township were also present: Lakes Bixley and Tamaracouta. They came to observe what we are doing and draw inspiration from it.

As he does every year, environmental biologist Matt Madison attended the meeting.

The organizing committee also gained a valuable new member — Pierre Bruyère from Lake Cambria.

Let us recall the Alliance's mission:

- Protecting the health of our lakes and shorelines
- Serving as a forum for Gore lake associations to maintain and enhance the health of our lakes, shorelines, and therefore our township

To achieve this, we focus on information sharing, communication and contribution as well as strengthening and expanding our partnership with the municipality.

We live close to our lakes and shorelines, we love our lakes, and we take care of them. But this does not happen on its own: it requires constant vigilance, a strong sense of responsibility, and a commitment to carrying out the same actions over and over again. This includes but is not limited to water testing, aquatic plant surveys, monitoring watercraft, etc. It also takes courage to intervene, when necessary, with individuals who do not respect the environment, wildlife, or plant life.

Once again, no suspicious aquatic invasive species were detected in 2025.

A huge thank you to all the volunteers who contributed. Special thanks go to the 14 volunteers from seven lakes who conducted the aquatic plant survey for Lake Beattie.

During the second part of the meeting, we welcomed Alain Giroux, Mayor of Gore, who answered many questions and shared several positive developments, including:

- Fireworks are now prohibited. Gore is harmonizing its regulations with those of Lachute and Wentworth (due to fire risk and pollution concerns).
- An emergency fund has been included in the 2026 budget in the event of an Eurasian Milfoil outbreak.
- A response protocol by the Municipality for invasive species incidents will be ready within a few weeks. Lake associations will then know exactly what to do and how to respond in a coordinated manner.
- More signs regarding mandatory boat washing will be installed.

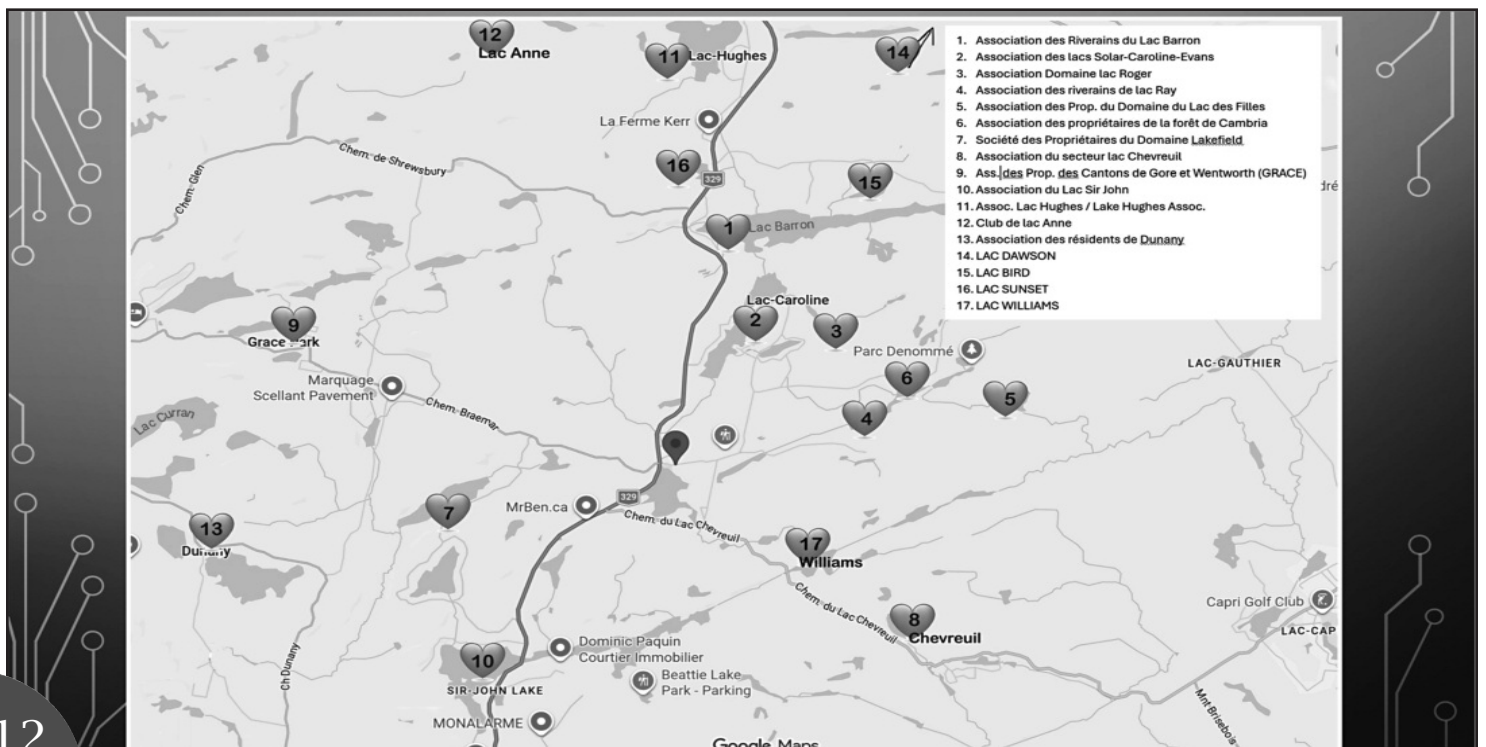
Other topics discussed included excessive lighting and septic system monitoring.

And for the first time, at the initiative of the municipality, the Alliance will hold an Environment Day on September 26th! More details to come...

In conclusion, it was a lively meeting with engaging discussions that highlighted the synergy built over time among the lakes and with the municipality.

The final message? Let us maintain this momentum of communication, continue all the efforts made by volunteers, and rely on the municipality's support; let us prioritize proactive action!
